

CUA20113 Certificate II in Dance

Course Information Brochure



Description of Course

This course enables students to develop knowledge and skills to participate in a variety of dance routine roles. It provides fundamental skills in a number of specialised dance disciplines. This is also a VCE VET subject and students gain a scored assessment for their ATAR as one of their primary four scaled studies or a 10% contribution to their ATAR score.

Activities/tasks

- Dance styles learnt Latin, Commercial Jazz/ Hip Hop and Cultural
- Ballet is an option for technically trained students (may not be offered in 2018)
- Performance and an annual dance concert
- Theory Classes

Assessment

The assessment involves a variety of methods including short answer questions, performances, responses to scenarios, and observation/'third party reports'. The assessment of overall competence at this Certificate level will be undertaken by a qualified assessor and competence judged using set criteria in the qualification. All training resources will be provided upon payment and enrolment.

Eligibility and prerequisites

Students enrolling in the CUA20113 Certificate II in Dance must be physically able to undertake the qualification. In addition they need to demonstrate the basic literacy and numeracy skills required to undertake a certificate level qualification.

Pathways

Students can study Certificate III level through to an Advanced Diploma at other institutions. The course is a pathway to further education and training in the entertainment industry. The Dance teacher / trainer informs students of industry audition opportunities happening at the end of the year and into the beginning of the following year.

Course Fees

Length of the Course

The course is delivered one half day per week over two years. You will be provided with a schedule and training plan for completing assessment tasks for each unit.
