22569VIC Certificate II in Plumbing (Pre-apprenticeship)



The course covers the knowledge and skills to prepare students for an entry into an apprenticeship. There is a strong practical focus. A range of units introduces students to basic plumbing knowledge and skills and the opportunity to develop skills for the industry in the plumbing workshop. There is a strong emphasis on sustainability and safe plumbing principles.

ACTIVITIES/TASKS

During the course, students will be able to complete projects that include:

- Sheet metalwork
- Plumbing fixtures and fittings for domestic and commercial applications
- Technical drawing and plumbing specifications
- Levelling
- Water, sanitary and drainage pipes used in plumbing

^{*}Students will be enrolled for the first aid unit with 1 SDO TRAINING (RTO Number 41558) and they will deliver the certificates. Their trainers will deliver the unit at NCAT.

LENGTH OF COURSE

The course can be completed either as a NCAT Pre-apprenticeship student over one year or as a year 10, VCE VM student for half day per week over two years. External students enrol through their home school and attend for half day per week over two years.

ELIGIBILITY & PREREQUISITES

It is recommended students have a minimum sound achievement of Year 10 Maths and English or equivalent and an aptitude for practical work. If you have individual needs, please contact the college.

ASSESSMENT

The completion of written and observed practical tasks and projects for each unit are assessed using set criteria. Students are given a fair and adequate assessment process that includes multiple opportunities to demonstrate competency.

Students are encouraged to do a minimum of 80 hours Structured Workplace Learning.

BENEFITS OF TRAINING

This certificate II course is for students wanting an introduction to the Plumbing/Building industry. It may assist people experiencing difficulties in gaining a full-time apprenticeship.

The course helps students make an informed choice of vocation or career path.

APPLICATION & ENROLMENT PROCESS

Students wanting to study full time at NCAT must arrange an interview phone 9478 1333. External students must complete two forms.

This course provides an excellent foundation and pathways to certificate III courses in Plumbing or other building industry level III qualifications. Following the successful completion of the course you can pursue an apprenticeship or traineeship.

- Mechanical Service -ventilation, duct fixing, heating/air-conditioning
- Domestic and commercial plumbing
