CUA20720 Certificate II In Visual Arts



This course is designed to provide participants with the opportunity to build skills and knowledge in Art and Design. Classes are run in a simulated work environment where students follow professional practices and WH&S guidelines. It covers diverse occupations in the visual arts, craft and design industries across a wide range of specialisations and media.

ACTIVITIES/TASKS

Students explore a range of techniques in drawing, sculpture, painting, printmaking, and apply these skills to briefs. They develop a basic knowledge of art history and the industry through lectures, discussion and personal experience. Students also visit galleries, artist and design studios, and work with visiting artists from Melbourne's creative community.

LENGTH OF COURSE

This program runs for one half day per week over two years.

ASSESSMENT

Students receive informal feedback from the teacher during the year in class time and are formally assessed at end of semester evaluation interviews. Assessment is based on submission of set tasks. If all course requirements are met, students receive their certificate at the end of the course.

The assessment of overall competence at this certificate level is undertaken by a qualified assessor and competence is judged using the criteria stated in the qualification.

Students will be given a fair and adequate assessment process that includes multiple opportunities to demonstrate competency.

PATHWAYS

This course enables students to progress towards a range of courses at NCAT and alternate providers.

Students completing one year of this course are eligible to continue completion of the second year within the full time Arts Immersion course at NCAT. This course combines the Certificate II and III in Visual Arts with the Victorian Certificate of Applied Learning in order to provide an arts focused experience for students completing Year 11 and 12.

Successful completion of the two years, resulting in a Certificate II in Visual Arts prepares students for entry into further study including:

- Certificate III in Visual Arts
- Certificate IV in Visual Arts / Certificate IV in Design
- Certificate IV in Photo Imaging

These courses are all offered at NCAT within the Folio Preparation and NCAT Photography departments and provide further learning to support entry into graduate study at Diploma and University level. Additionally, the Certificate II in Visual Arts is a recognised qualification for entry into higher levels at alternate providers.
